### Definitions

- Cause: a person or thing that makes something happen
- Effect: a result; a change caused by something else
- Impact: The powerful effect that one thing has on something else

### Examples

- Cause: Fossil fuels are a cause of pollution.
- Effect: Pollution is an effect of fossil fuels.
- Impact: Fossil fuels have an impact on the environment.

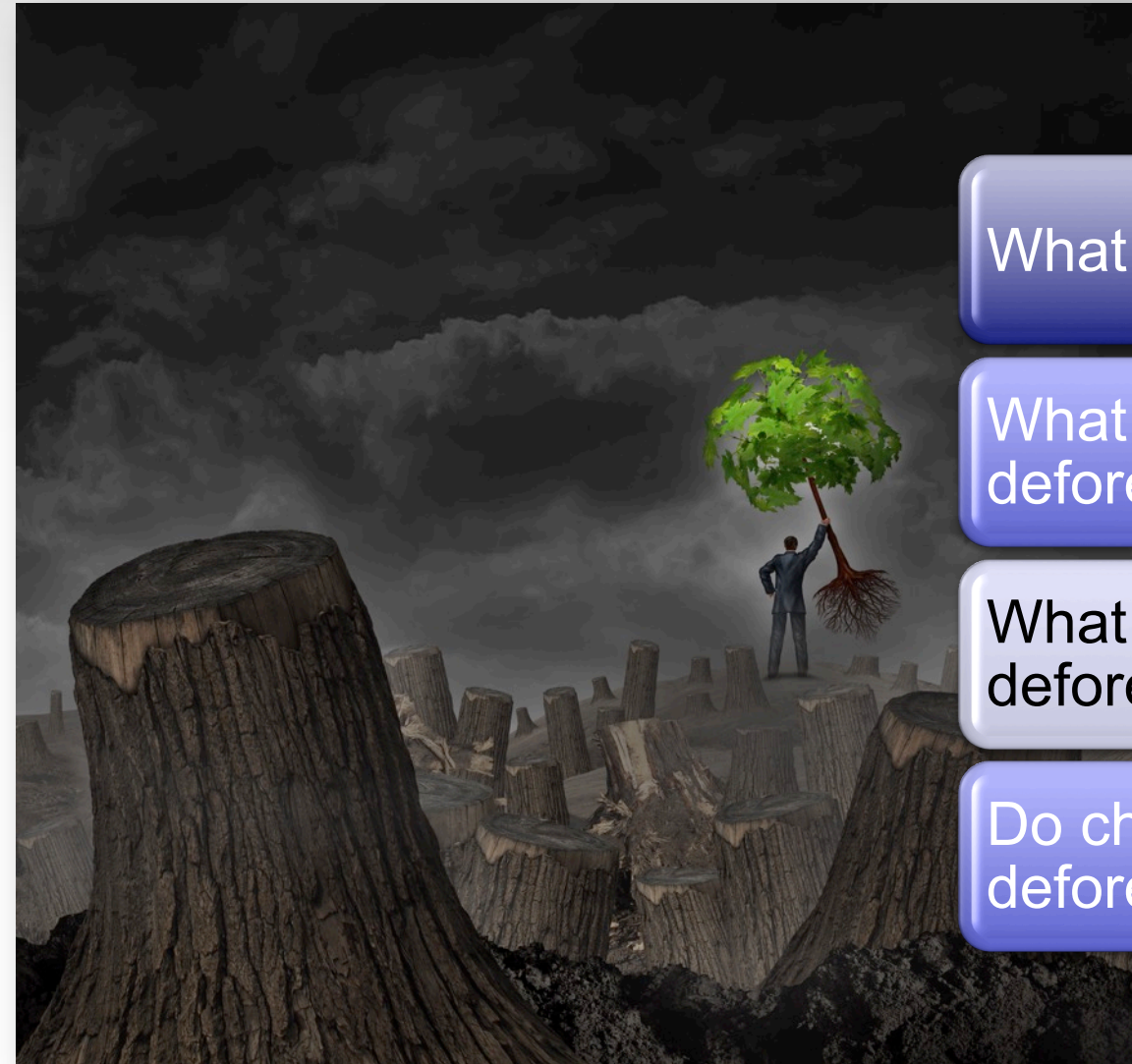

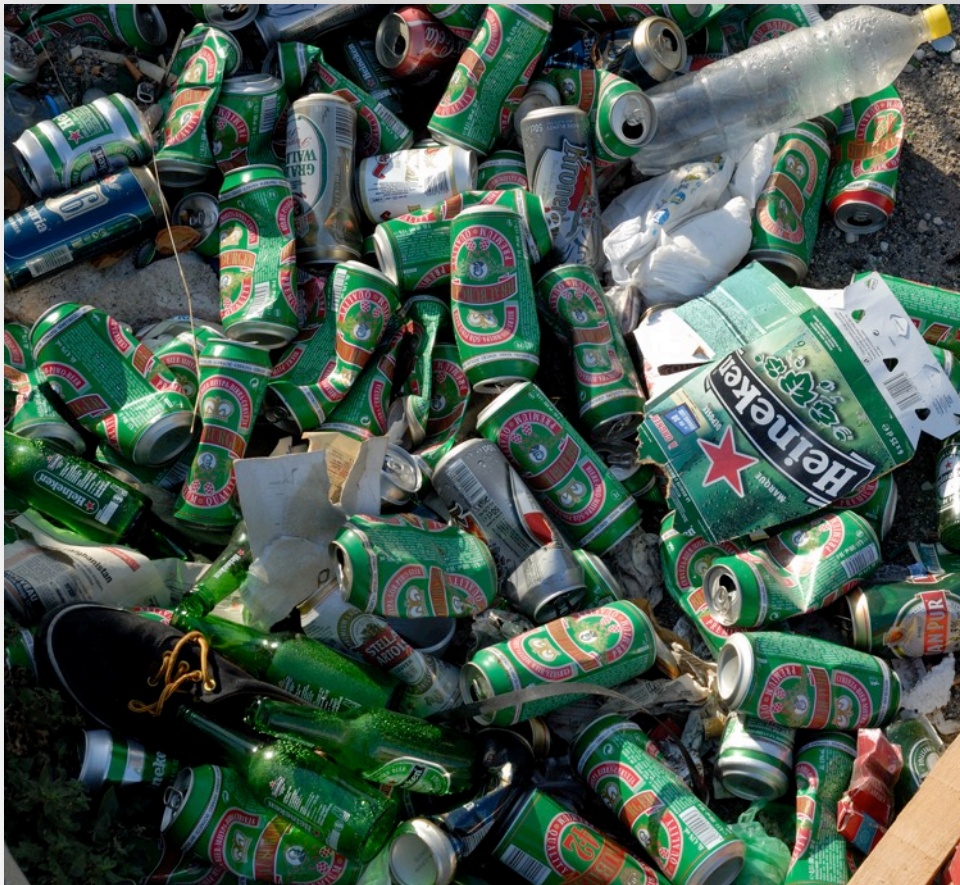

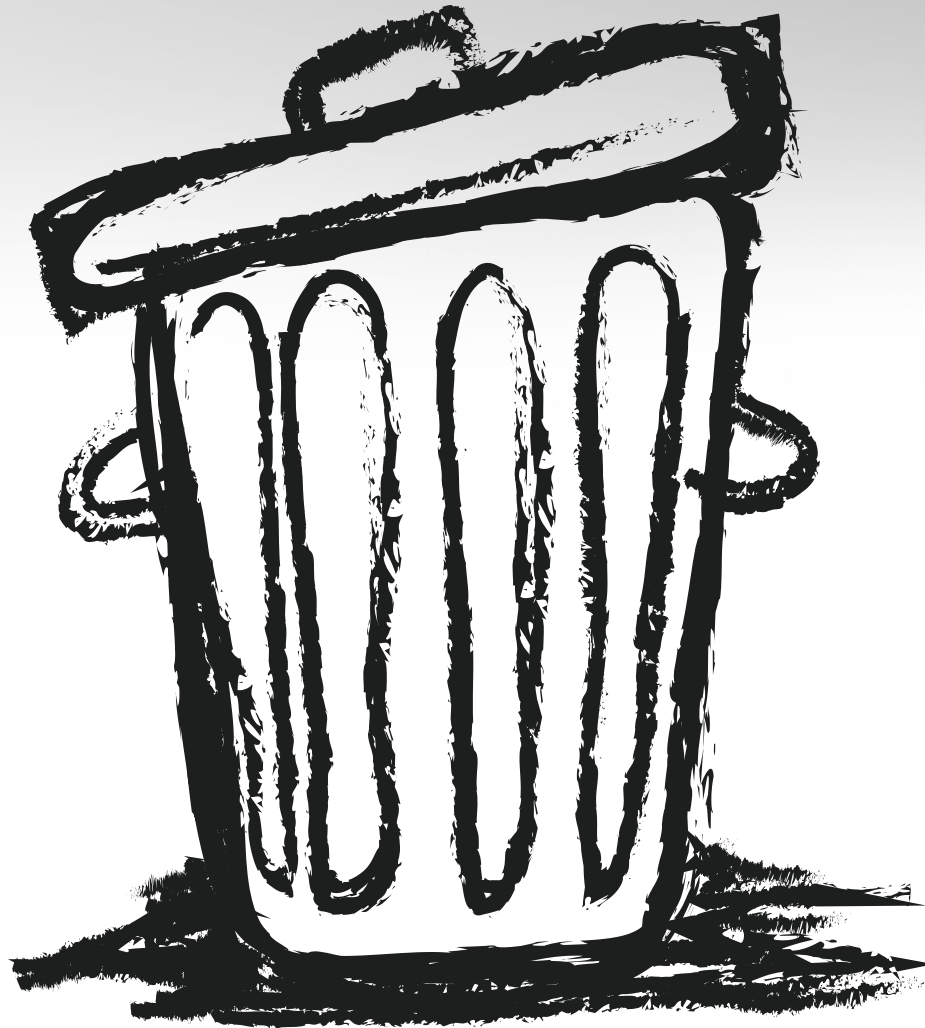
